



Avonmore Fair 4-H Virtual Dairy & Beef Calf Rally – 2021

General Rules and Regulations

1. The show is open to all 2021 4-H members with registered animals with their provincial organization who reside in Region 2 or Western Quebec.
2. Each 4-H member may enter one animal in the dairy classes and one animal in the beef classes.
3. Each 4-H member must participate in both the showmanship and conformation classes
4. Age categories for beef & dairy showmanship classes:
 - Junior (9 – 12 years of age)
 - Intermediate (13 – 17 years of age)
 - Senior (18 – 21 years of age)
5. All breeds will be judged together in the conformation classes:
 - Dairy Classes:
 - Junior Calf: March 1, 2021 or younger
 - Intermediate Calf: December 1, 2020 to February 28, 2021
 - Senior Calf: September 1, 2020 to November 30, 2020
 - Summer Yearling: June 1, 2020 to August 31, 2020
 - Junior Yearling: March 1, 2020 to May 31, 2020
 - Beef Classes:
 - Beef Calf: January 1, 2021 to May 31, 2021
 - Junior Yearling: March 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020
 - Senior Yearling: January 1, 2020 to February 28, 2020
 - Beef Steer
6. The Avonmore 4-H Calf Rally has the right to disqualify any exhibitor should it believe the rules have not been followed.
7. Deadline to register is July 10/21 until 11:59 pm through AssistExpo.

8. The placings by the official judges are final. Results will be posted on the Avonmore Fair Facebook page & website on July 18, 2021.
9. Once the videos have been submitted, the videos and pictures become the property of the Roxborough Agricultural Society.
10. The 4-H Animal does not need to be registered with a breed association however a CCIA tag number is required to be able to submit on AssistExpo.
11. Prize monies will be paid out for both showmanship and conformation classes.



Conformation & Showmanship Rules and Regulations

1. 4-H members will be required to submit a video for both the conformation and showmanship classes.
2. Video Requirements:
 - Animals must be haltered and led by the 4-H member in both videos.
 - No farm names, farm signs or farm logos may be permitted in the background of the videos.
 - The video must be taken horizontally.
 - For showmanship, the video must be between 120-180 seconds and for conformation the video must be between 60 – 120 seconds.
 - Animal should be shown on a smooth surface. No straw or shavings.
 - Take the video of your animal as if you were in the show ring. Each video must include a show side, front, rear, side and back views on the move. It should include the motions if a judge was completing an individual inspection (i.e. feet switches).
 - Each view should be taken from afar and close-up to the animal (must get within 6 feet of the animal).
 - Videos must be filmed from July 1, 2021 to July 10, 2021 and must be date stamped or cell phone verified.
 - The video quality must be 720p or higher. Submission files to be one of the following formats: .mov, .mp4, .mpg or .mpeg.
 - No edited videos will be accepted.
3. Exhibitors must be in proper show attire.
4. Animals must be clipped and prepared for a show ring.
